

How To: Pay Estimated Tax to Alabama

NOTES: You owe estimated tax *personally*, which is why you have to set up an account with My Alabama Tax using your personal tax information (name, SSN, etc) in order to pay your Alabama estimated tax.

What you will need:

- Name, Address, SSN
- Alabama AGI (*Adjust Gross Income*) form most recent tax return: \$
 - See Alabama Form 40, Line 10 for AGI.
 - You may need to ask your tax preparer for this information if you can't locate it.

HOW TO:

1. Go to My Alabama Tax: <https://myalabamataxes.alabama.gov/>
2. Click: "Create My Alabama Taxes" account

My Alabama Taxes Debit Block Code to Change by End of January 2024

Before January 31, 2024, if you pay taxes through My Alabama Taxes using accounts that employ a debit block which requires an Originating Company ID (or "debit block code") to be approved for ACH debits, then you must provide to your bank or financial institution an additional debit block code.
